Pediatric catheter



very year in France, around 400 babies are born with a heart defect called transposition of the great vessels in which the main arteries of the heart are inverted, causing the baby to not receive enough oxygen in their blood to fuel their body. This condition is life-threatening immediately from birth, often requiring instantaneous surgery, sometimes even in the delivery room. The tools that currently exist for such a procedure are not suitable. which complicates the operation. The Lirve University Hospital Institute responded to this specific need by developing a dedicated pediatric catheter. This innovative device is designed to adapt to the anatomical particularities of babies. thereby facilitating emergency procedures and significantly reducing the associated risks. The development of this pediatric catheter represents major progress.

- Ease in accurately visualizing problems causing critical conditions, such as atrial fibrillation and sudden cardiac arrest.
- improved diagnostics and treatment strategies. Doctors can detect the slightest irregularities in the heart structure, with unprecedented clarity.

he field of cardiac imaging is poised for a revolution with the introduction of a state-of-the-art photon-counting computed tomography scanner on the Liryc platform. This new equipment represents a major advancement in image resolution capacity, far surpassing current technologies, with spatial precision that has never been achieved before.

This innovative scanner will allow extremely detailed analysis of heart tissue, paving the way for significant progress in both research and diagnosis of heart disease.

This technological development offers a unique window into the structural anomalies of the heart.

 Enables adaptation and innovation in therapies offered to women. trial fibrillation presents unique characteristics and challenges in women, making it more complex to treat compared with men. Women tend to have more severe symptoms and experience greater impairment in their quality of life, as well as a higher risk of certain complications, including strokes

Faced with this situation, the Liryc teams tackled the problem. They are now carrying out an exploratory study to determine what role the fluctuation of sexual hormones, during pregnancy and menopause, plays in the development of atrial fibrillation.

Through a better understanding of arrhythmia triggers, new hopes are emerging, particularly for more effective treatment solutions.
